Please review RFP release #2 for the revised language.
		<ol> <li>Response to Q96 states that SOC 2 is required, whereas E.10. Contractor Hosted Services Confidential Data, Audit, and Other Requirements shows the requirement to be deleted. Could you please clarify?</li> </ol>	The language struck through from release 2 is being deleted. SOC 2 Type II audits are required as set forth in contract section E.10.e. Please note the tracked changes and comments have been removed from the release 2 and are no longer reflected on the RFP document.
		<ol> <li>It is requested that the response to Question #74 be added to the RFP.</li> </ol>	The RFP already contains information about forms and template requirements. Please refer to the following sections for more details: A.4.q., A.4.w, A.4.aa, A.4.ee, A.4.ll, and A.4.eee. The selected contractor is responsible for configuring approximately 200 standard e-forms, sub-forms, and templates. These templates will enable users to create letters and documents using data extracted from IRIS, modify the content of the document, and save the form as a Word document. The State has yet to determine at this time the exact number of templates IRIS will need to store over the life of the contract. Respondent should be aware that the number of templates stored is subject to change at State discretion. The State will make the templates currently in use available to the selected contractor.
		<ol> <li>It is requested that reconsideration of redaction of demonstrations be considered for product proprietary purposes.</li> </ol>	See Section 4.8 of the RFP.
