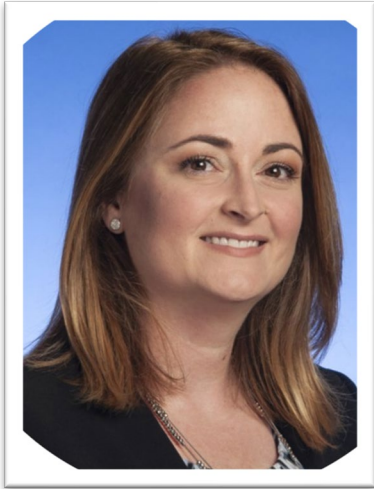

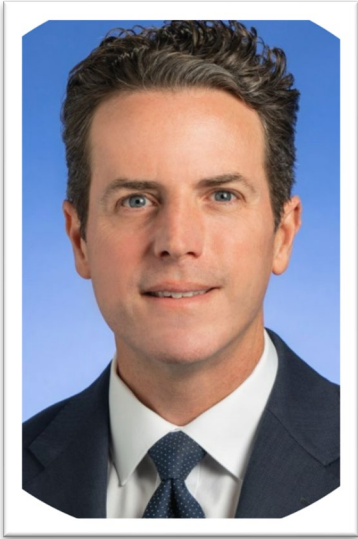

# Review of SmartSimple

- SmartSimple is a grants management web-based platform that is owned by the State of Tennessee for government use. Many Tennessee state departments administer grants, and this platform was acquired to streamline the process.
- Grantees and state employees can apply, score, award, communicate and issue a contract through SmartSimple. SmartSimple is integrated with Edison, the state payment and contractor system.
- SmartSimple is supported through the Tennessee state IT department – Strategic Technology Solutions – or STS, which is the centralized IT department created under Governor Haslam.
- Tennessee state departments may use SmartSimple for a nominal fee (around \$30 a transaction). There is no bidding or contracting with STS, as this is an enterprise-wide technology service available to state departments.
- Other attributes:
  - It is an 'off-the-shelf' product
  - It is customizable
  - There is tech support
  - All actions and statuses of the grant process are tracked and operationalized within SmartSimple
- Tennessee state departments using SmartSimple:
  - Department of Health
  - Department of Labor and Workforce
  - Department of Environment and Conservation
  - Office of Criminal Justice Programs (Finance and Administration)
